Council of Boards of School Education in India (COBSE) a provides common platform for mutual consultation for reinforcing the quality of School education. COBSE was created in 1979. It is an apex body of all boards/councils of secondary / senior secondary in the country. It was registered by CBSE under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 in 1979 to provide academic support to its member-boards on setting and maintenance of educational standards, curriculum planning, developing curriculum material, evaluation etc. In fact, the main objective of COBSE is to take steps of improve the quality of school education in collaboration with its member-boards. Presently, Mr. Vineet Joshi, IAS, Chairman, CBSE is the President of COBSE.

Association of Indian University (AIU)

What is A.I.U.

The idea of bringing together all the universities on a common platform emerged from the deliberations of a Conference of the Vice Chancellors of Universities convened by Lord Reading, the then Viceroy of India at Shimla in 1924. The Inter- University Board (IUB) of India was subsequently formed on March 23, 1925, with the view of promoting university activities, especially by way of sharing information and co-operation in the field of education, culture, sports and allied areas. The Inter-University Board acquired a legal status with its registration in 1967 as a Society under the Societies Registration ACT, 1860. In 1973, it assumed its parent name : The association of Indian Universities (AIU) The membership includes traditional universities, open universities, professional universities, Institutes of National Importance and deemed-to-be universities. In addition, there is a provision of granting of Associate Membership to universities of neighbouring countries.

Policy on Pursuing two or more Programmes Simultaneously

The Distance Education Council in its 40th meeting held on 08 June 2012 approved a policy on pursuing two or more programmes simultaneously in various combinations as under.

Two Degree Programmes cannot be allowed to be pursued simultaneously. However, a student can pursue two programmes simultaneously through distance mode or combination of distance and regular modes from the same or different Universities / Institutions in various combinations, viz.,

- ❖ One Degree and one Diploma/ P G Diploma/ Certificate.
- ❖ One P G Diploma and one Diploma/ Certificate.
- ❖ One Diploma and one Certificate.
- ❖ Two P G Diplomas.
- ❖ Two Diplomas.
- ❖ Two Certificate.
